Sonoma County artists, both professional and amateur, are invited to participate in the Art Contest for Fish Fest 2018. The winning entry becomes the logo for the 2018 Fisherman's Festival. Additionally, the winning entry will be featured on printed materials, advertising, an 11 X 17 inch poster, t-shirts and other clothing as well as on the Fish Fest website and throughout the festival. The winning artwork is selected by a "blind" jury (i.e. the name and address of the artist is masked). Only the Chair of the Art Contest will have all information on each candidate.

The original artwork should be 11 X 17 inches. It should be signed, but masked with a post-it or other masking method. Include a self-addressed prepaid mailer for return artwork to artist, a 3X5 card with artist name, address and art identifier or description. (i.e. Jane Doe, 100 Main St., Jenner CA 95450, seascape with fish.) Artwork must reflect the 2018 theme: **"Bodega Bay Fishing. Real People. To enter, drop off original artwork at the Bodega Bay Fire Protection District, 510 Hwy. 1, Bodega Bay:
Monday, January 8 through Friday, January 12, and must be enclosed in paper wrapping with no visible name. Entries will be picked up daily, but the final pickup is 5PM, Friday, January 12, 2018. EACH step must be followed to win.

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED BY 5 PM ON FRIDAY, JANUARY 12, 2018.

All original artwork will be returned to the artist.
