

Bodega Bay Fisherman's Festival

Scholarship Application Guidelines

PURPOSE: This scholarship may be used for tuition, fees or books at a junior college, four-year college or university, tech or trade school.

ELIGIBILITY: Applicants **must reside** in Bodega Bay, Bodega, Valley Ford, Bloomfield, Tomales and Dillon Beach.

CRITERIA: Applicants must earn a high school diploma OR earn a G.E.D. the year of the application. Student must be enrolled full-time the full academic year of high school graduation OR file for a one-year postponement of the scholarship. Any portion of the scholarship not used or disbursed within a reasonable amount of time (depending upon program), will be returned to the Bodega Bay Fisherman's Festival Scholarship Fund.

SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS will be notified at the high school's award ceremony. The funds will be disbursed by a check made payable to the institution and the recipient.
