VOLUNTEERS:

- Make sure to arrive 15 minutes before your shift to make for an easy transition.
- All shifts are 4 hours.
- If your children or pets come to the Festival, please have someone else be responsible for them during your volunteer shift.
- Bodega Bay weather is unpredictable. We recommend dressing in layers and wear comfortable shoes.
- We suggest you bring drinking water in a refillable water bottle.
- CHECK IN AND OUT AT THE VOLUNTEER CHECK-IN GATE (NORTH GATE). This will ensure your organization will receive credit for your time.
